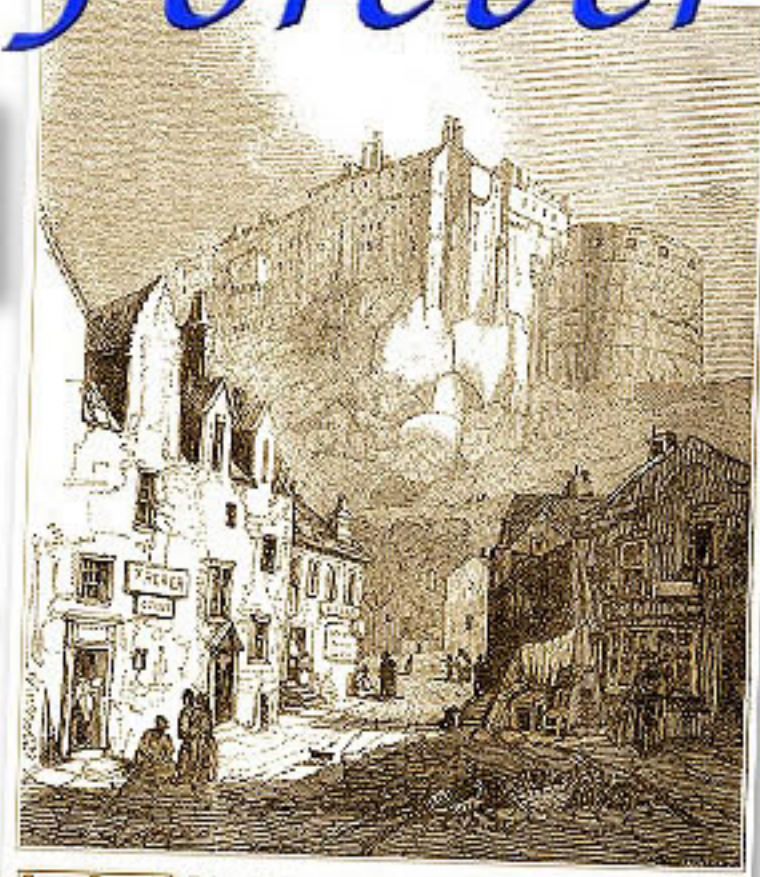
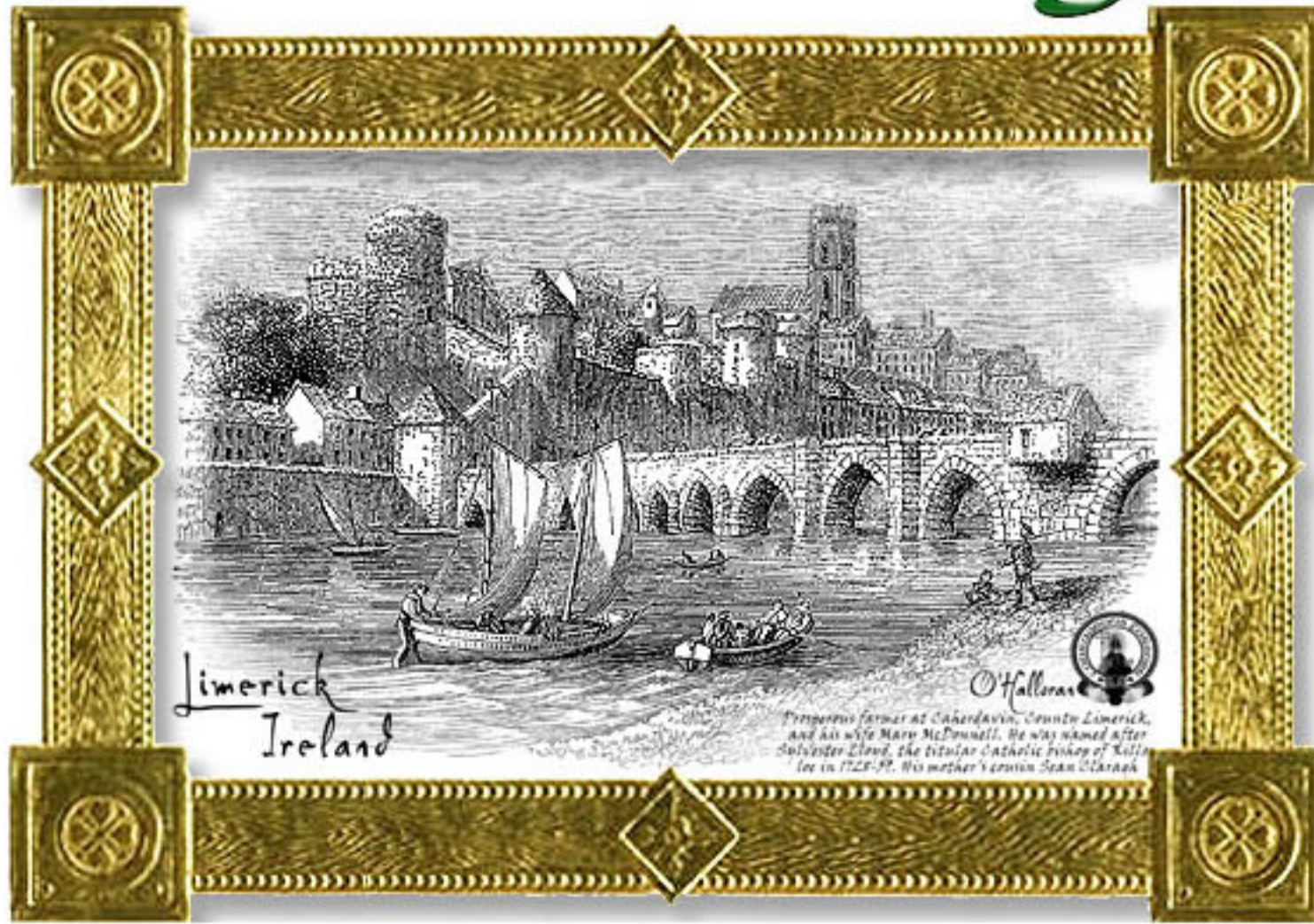
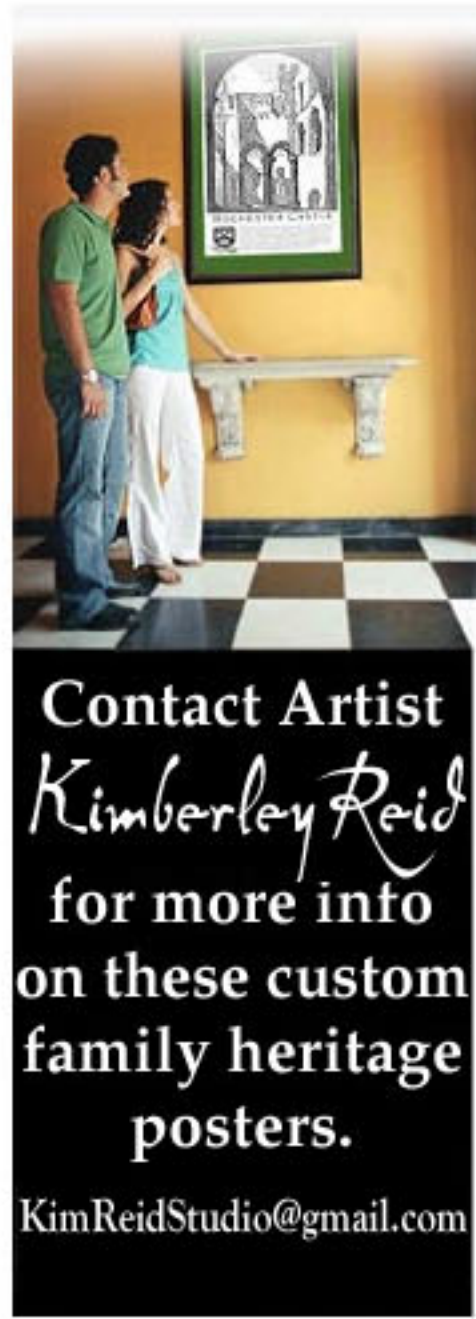

This Spanish surname Terreras was a locational name for one who lived by a flat or agricultural lane, rendered in medieval documents in the Latin form TERRERA, meaning land. In Spain the Villages of Terreras, Salamanca, Castilla is in the province of Leon. The Kingdom of Leon had been an independent kingdom situated in the northwest region of the Spanish Iberian Peninsula. It was founded in 910 AD. In 1068 the Kingdom of Leon developed the first Parliament in Europe.

An early and famous Terreras family member was the Bishop of Leon, Francisco Terreras del Cado, born in 1206. The Santa Maria de Leon Cathedral, also called The House of Light or the Pulchra Leprosaria was built in the mid-12th century, by master architect Enrique.



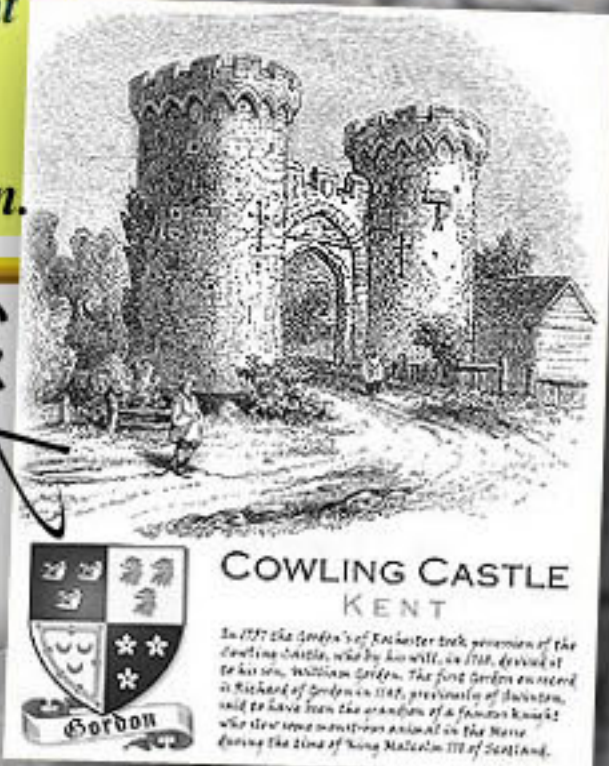
The Morales family stems from medieval Spain, known then as Castile the Christian Kingdom, from the year 711 AD to 1492, and León. One of the earliest known members this family moved to the new world, Andrés Morales 1677-1727, accompanied Christopher Columbus on his third expedition to America in 1498. Another early known famous Morales was Francisco de Morales Cabral 1519-1525. He was a Portuguese writer and served as secretary to the Portuguese ambassador in France, Cristóbal de Morales 1528-1595 was the most influential musical composer of the Spanish Renaissance.

The Morales surname means "son of moral" a given name meaning "right and proper." They were also known for their cultivation of mulberry and blackberry for wine and grapes.

There are 3 different villages in Spain, named after the Morales family: San Morales is located in the province of Salamanca, Morales de Rey, Morales de Toro, Morales de Valverde and Morales del Vino are all located in the province of Zamora.



The Crathes name has English roots and means approximately "mountain-fort", which gives an indication to its origins. To the north of the present High Street an area of open ground called Castle Park preserves almost exactly the hidden perimeter of an Iron Age promontory fort. The Battle of Dunbar in 1650 was a battle in the Third English Civil War. The Scottish forces held their ground impregnable fortifications around Edinburgh.
